The organ is a completely free-standing instrument with casework on all four sides. The keydesk is a new mechanical coupler chassis with new manual keyboards and aluminum parts. All manual trackers are aluminum. The stop actions and rollerboards are all original material. The organ is totally intact and was fully functional when dismantled and removed to storage. It has its own Meidinger blower but not original large bellows. The facade pipes have been stripped of paint and are bare zinc with traces of original stenciled designs remaining. The case is of oak and needs only minor repair. Presently in storage.
