



FOR generations the PIPE ORGAN has been the accepted musical instrument for the house of worship. No other instrument satisfactorily meets the needs of the worship service. Today, as in the past, the desire of all churches, large or small, is to have a real pipe organ.

Realizing a definite responsibility to the small church and chapel, MÖLLER has painstakingly studied the problem and the results are the ARTISTE PIPE ORGANS. Materials and workmanship are of the same high quality that have made the name MÖLLER synonymous with the best for over three quarters of a century.



Detached console conforms to standards recommended by the American Guild of Organists. The console shown above, of the six stop ARTISTE, has two expression pedals, unusual in an organ of this size. All ARTISTE consoles occupy a space less than five feet square.



The Artiste Pipe Organs include attractive cabinets to enclose mechanism and pipes.

THE three stop ARTISTE meets the need for a compact self-contained instrument of genuine pipe organ tone. All pipes and mechanism, except blower, are contained within the organ case which is only 3'6" deep, 8'0" wide and 8'0" high. The action, as in all ARTISTE organs, is the time tested MÖLLER electro-pneumatic type, built with the finest materials and workmanship. Now the smallest church can have a real pipe organ at a cost comparable to substitutes.
